# Revised By-laws

## 2013 Re-Stated By-laws of The Manitowoc Yacht Club Inc.

Revisions Voted/Carried: October 29, 2013, Effective: January 1, 2014

### ARTICLE 1. MEMBERSHIP CLASSES: REVISED OCTOBER 2013

Membership shall be divided into classes as follow:

- (1) **Full Membership:** Members consist of a primary member and spouse or committed partner. Members must be at least 21 years of age and have paid the club initiation fees and dues and have complied with all other regulations governing membership admission.  
**Single Members:** Members consist of a primary member that is at least 21 years of age and have paid the club initiation fees and dues and have complied with all other regulations governing membership admission. (Note: This classification is for single individuals without a spouse or committed partner, they are allowed guests but those guests do not have all club privileges).
- (2) **Honorary Membership:** Prior to 1/1/2014, no fees and classification stays the same. After 1/1/2014, this classification ceases to exist. Existing honorary members will keep their classification (grandfathered).
- (3) **Life Members:** Any full or single member in good standing reaching the age of 65 years old and a total of at least twenty consecutive years (including apprenticeship year) as an active member in this organization is eligible for life membership provided such application is made to the Board of Directors in writing and accepted.  
*Note: Life Membership entitles that person to all full or single membership privileges, responsibilities and other club rules. Effective January 1 2014, the member shall pay 50% of the current full membership dues or 50% of the current single membership dues, and will increase as dues increase. These members are also subject to any special assessments determined by the Board of Directors (reviewed yearly). Prior to January 1 2014, existing life members will be grandfathered, not having to pay annual dues.*
- (4) **Past Commodore:** Any member completing one full elected year, as commodore of this club will automatically be given a life membership.  
*Note: Life Membership entitles that person to all full or single membership privileges, responsibilities and other club rules. Effective January 1 2014, the member shall pay 50% of the current full membership dues or 50% of the current single membership dues, and will increase as dues increase. These members are also subject to any special assessments determined by the Board of Directors (reviewed yearly). Prior to January 1 2014, existing life members will be grandfathered, not having to pay annual dues.*
- (5) **Apprentice Member:** New members shall be voted on to fill vacancies as are available in the roster and they shall be selected in order from the waiting membership list. New members shall serve as apprentices for one calendar year, January 1 thru December 31: shall attend meetings and shall perform hours of labor as required by the club. They shall have all the rights to membership except voting. At the end of the apprentice year they shall become members providing the have completed their required duties of their membership class and have paid their dues.

### ARTICLE 4. MEETINGS OF MEMBERS

Section 4. Voting of the Membership: Each eligible membership classification shall have one vote at any membership meeting.

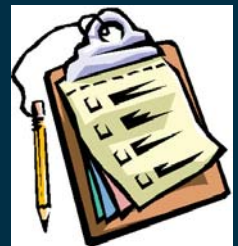
