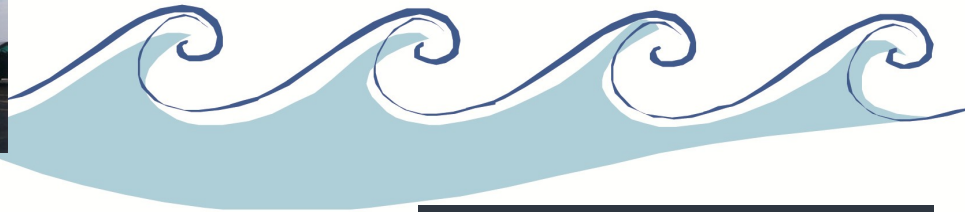

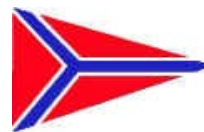
Letter from Commodore Ed Hansen

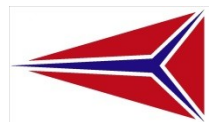
