Letter from Commodore Chad Radtke



Hello All,

August has arrived and it looks like a lot is happening around the area. Coincidentally, there isn't much happening at the club... And when there isn't much going on, you get a chance to look into some of the things on the rainy day list. Those would be over pouring and the capital improvement fund.

Let's start with over pouring... This problem has probably been happening for as long as we've had booze in the club. And it is a problem that effects more of us than we think... Even me.

I found out when I bartended for a band night a while back when I had a guy who ordered an old fashioned. Being that I wasn't sure how to make an old fashioned before that night, I was a little surprised when he kept coming back for more. So the next day or so, and feeling much more confident, I made my wife an old fashioned and found out it was very boozy.

So, I would challenge you to use the jigger and see how you measure up... All those extra ounces add up to extra bottles that cause extra expense which eventually all the membership will need to cover.

Next, we'll discuss the Capital Improvement Fund... It's almost empty and these are the reasons why...

- Galley prep sink food disposal replacement/upgrade: \$2,320.00
- Washer/dryer including all plumbing/electrical work to hook them up: \$2,059.74
- Galley hood grease fan replacement/upgrade: \$4,223.80
- Deep fryer replacement (both units): \$3,049.20
- Air conditioner replacement: \$3,741.40

Total: \$14,924.14

I hope this is the end of things that come up this year. And if so, we had enough in the fund to cover it all. And as of yesterday, the account still had **\$590.52 remaining**.

However, my understanding is that the other 4 air conditioning units will need to be replaced in the upcoming years. There is also some concern about needing a roof in the next 5-10 years. Based on conversations about the financial health of our club with the accountant, the Capital Improvement Fund should be somewhere between \$30,000-50,000. I'm not sure what adjustments can/will be made to get there or how quickly we can or need to get there, but I think it's prudent to the future viability of our club we take small steps now to avoid big steps later.

Finally, on a lighter note, my August arrived with the fulfillment of a long-held dream... To sail across Lake Michigan... And thanks to Dave Bauman, who allowed me to tag along with Dave Wilhelm and Jerry Hein for their crossing to Ludington on his boat, Tenacity, I have done it and it was every bit as great as I thought it would be.

Recipe Corner

Grilled Grouper with Watermelon Salsa

Ingredients

- 4 (4-oz.) grouper fillets
- 1 teaspoon freshly ground pepper
- 1 teaspoon salt, divided
- 3 tablespoons olive oil, divided
- 2 cups chopped seedless watermelon
- 1/4 cup chopped pitted olives (optional)
- 1/2 cucumber, chopped
- 1 small jalapeño pepper, seeded and minced
- 2 tablespoons minced red onion
- 2 tablespoons white balsamic vinegar



Preparation

1. Preheat grill to 350° to 400° (medium-high) heat. Sprinkle grouper with pepper and 1/2 tsp. salt. Drizzle with 2 Tbsp. olive oil.
2. Grill fish, covered with grill lid, 3 to 4 minutes on each side or just until fish begins to flake when poked with the tip of a sharp knife and is opaque in center.
3. Combine chopped watermelon, next 5 ingredients, and remaining 1/2 tsp. salt and 1 Tbsp. olive oil. Serve with grilled fish.

I made this the other night. It turned out awesome, and very refreshing with this hot weather we are having. ENJOY!

How to Sponsor a New Member
