Fill out "New Member Proposal Form" found next to the bulletin board or print a form from the Membership Page of the website.

Attend a Board of Directors meeting and bring the form to present to the Board. The proposals are posted for 30 days on the bulletin board. If there are no objections to the proposed members then they will be approved by the Board at the next meeting.

Once approved, an application and letter is sent to the sponsors. The sponsor is responsible for having the proposed member fill out and return the application to the club within 60 days. The order in which the applications are returned is the order placed on the Wait List.

Failure to return the application prior to the stated date will still count towards yearly sponsorship. Members are allowed two sponsorships per year.

Your decorations can have a theme or just be a bunch of lights thrown on the boat. Registration form is located on the club bulletin board. You can email to brkulas@gmail.com or drop off at the Marina Store by July 8.

Parade Participant Entry Requirements:

- 1) Have a properly registered, motor-driven vessel capable of safe travel in the dark.
- 2) The vessel meets all requirements for on-board safety equipment.
- 3) The vessel has on-board, an operational VHF marine radio.
- 4) At least 1 operational carbon monoxide detector on-board if a generator is in use during the parade.
- 5) The vessel operator **MUST** attend the "Captain's Meeting" on July 11th @ 6PM for a safety and procedures briefing at the Manitowoc Marina customer lounge. If you do not attend this meeting you will not be allowed to participate in the parade.
- 6) Be prepared to launch by 8:30 pm. More details will be disclosed at the Captain's Meeting.
- 7) The parade route will be in the harbor and up the river to 8th street.
