Hello All,

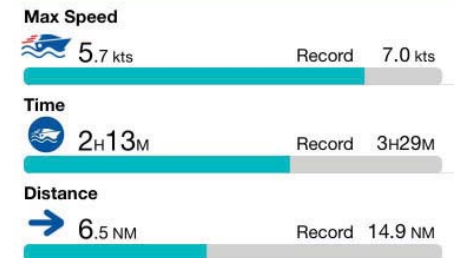
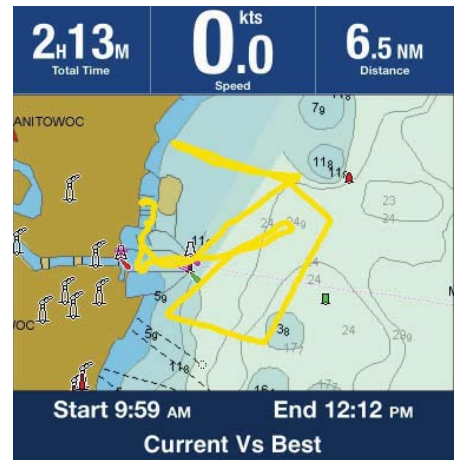
June was fun... We had the boat show... We had the return of Tom Sobel's band... And best of all, I got to go sailing (see photo). ---->

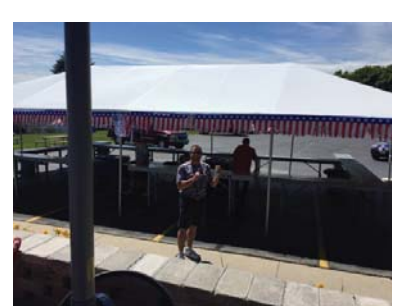
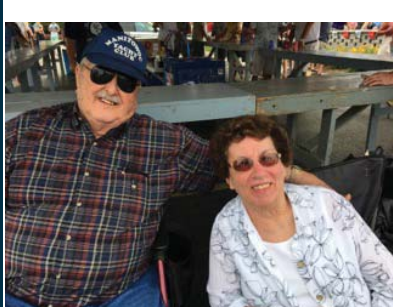
