The US Coast Guard Auxiliary is a volunteer service organization (much like the Civil Air Patrol) composed of men and women who actively support maritime safety and security missions as well as provide administrative and support services. The Auxiliary was established by Congress in 1939 and is currently expanding its role within the Coast Guard Team. This Auxiliary is authorized to perform all missions that Congress has authorized the Coast Guard to perform, with the exception of direct law enforcement and military action. The Two Rivers Auxiliary Flotilla provides services such as patrols at different community events, checks aids to navigation, teaches boating safety and training, and search and rescue, etc. The Two Rivers Flotilla has its own 21-foot patrol boat for use in "on the water" missions. 
