#### Managing Expectations By Ed Hansen

Over the past month I have gotten some negative feedback from members concerning member sponsored events, weddings, etc., here at the club. And with each, I found misunderstood expectations. Our club does not have a paid staff, (other than Friday dining and the bar manager) but members who volunteer their time to run the club. There is no paid event manager. So what does that mean? It means when you, as a member rent the club sponsoring an event, you are responsible for EVERYTHING! The club provides what we have, building, tables, chairs, etc. When you want something other than what the club provides it is up to you to arrange it or hire a vendor to supply it at your expense.

Another reminder, when you sponsor a non-member party you or a designated member must be present at ALL times, during setup, during the event, and after for cleanup. You are also required to have any leftover food removed immediately, or coordinate with the club to pickup or donate the food to a local food pantry or charity that takes prepared food. You are also responsible for the conduct of your guests, members and non-members alike.

We will be providing in the near future an inventory list of items and quantities available for use during an event such as tables, chairs, etc., which should answer most questions. If not? Ask questions but remembering, it's your party!

One final reminder, the members who are here almost daily doing the club's business are just like you, unpaid members! Don't take advantage of them!
