- 2012: In 50 Fridays - 5,949 dinners served total, average of 119 per week.
- 2013: In 49 Fridays - 6,667 dinners served total, average of 136 per week.
- 2014: In 50 Fridays - 7,082 dinners served total, average of 142 per week.
- 2015: In 51 Fridays - 7,292 dinners served total, average of 143 per week.

As you can see in the last couple of years our numbers have spiked up. Thank you for your part in patronizing our great club.
