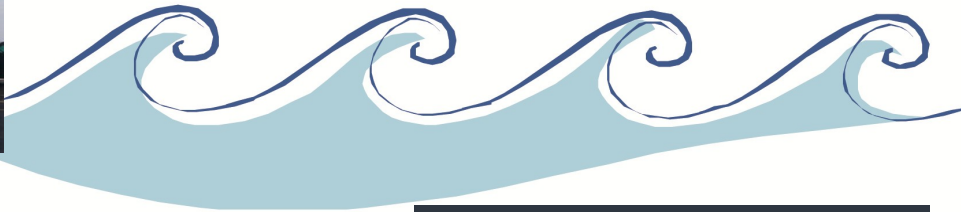

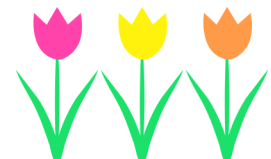
We have had a busy March with Wednesday 27th our second of the year Hamburger & Chili night. We sold 182

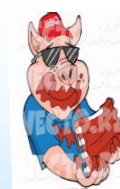

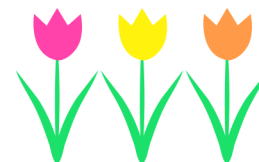

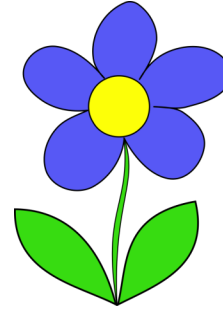
