#### 2021 VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES AT THE MANITOWOC YACHT CLUB

Please contact John Glaeser (Ph: 920.645.1102) to sign up for any of the following opportunities. The following can be completed by apprentices or members and will help to keep our club's maintenance costs down.

- Clean Windows
  - Inside
  - Outside
- Yard Work
  - Spring clean-up: pick up leaves, paper, etc from around the building, flower beds, and shrubs and along the top of the edge by the lake.
- Vacuum
  - o All of club: entry, bar area, Swan Room, dining room.
- Clean Kitchen
  - Wipe down all surfaces: counters, sinks walls (there are cleaners for these surfaces)
  - Sweep and mop kitchen floor, hallway to the bar, hallway by walk-in cooler, floor to the office, under all tables and racks (cleaning supplies available).
- Back Bar (in order, one section at a time)
  - o Remove all glasses and run them through the kitchen dishwasher.
  - Remove the mats that the glasses sit on and run them through the kitchen dishwasher.
  - Clean the windows.
  - Clean the back bar area.
  - Put mats and glasses back.
- Dusting
  - Anything that you can safely reach
- Clothing Cabinet
  - Make sure it's straight and neat. Clean, refold clothing, etc.
- Dishes and Cutlery in the Dining Room Cabinets and Drawers
  - o Take out dishes/cutlery and run through the kitchen dishwasher.
  - Clean the inside of all of cabinets before putting the clean dishes/cutlery back in place.
- Dusting with Vacuum Hose and Brush
  - Above door and window trims, bulletin board, window valances above the bar, valances in the dining room.
  - Possibly also the burgees and wood valance and lights in the Swan Room.
- Tables and Chairs
  - Bar chairs, high top tables and regular tables, including chairs in the bar area, Swan Room, and dining area.
  - Completely wipe down from top to bottom, including each individual spindles and legs
  - Wipe down the underside of tables and chairs in this process.
- Saturday Clean-up
  - After Friday Night Dining: Call John Glaeser to volunteer for Saturday morning clean-up.
