

We, Ladies of the Yacht Club each holiday season give to Manitowoc families-in-need selected by the Principals and Guidance Counselors of Jackson Elementary School from the North side and Franklin Elementary School from the South side. The families selected are <u>not</u> receiving assistance from any assistance program but face a hardship during the holidays to give to their families. Our gift giving in the past years has been enormously appreciated and will so more this year given COVID. (We apologize for the redundancy to our members who have so generously participated and given so graciously over the years but given no event or meeting we wanted to explain to all in detail.)

In the past years, we, Ladies of the Yacht Club hold events during the year to raise money such as Dessert Nights, 50/50 Raffle, annual Christmas Party & Program etc. and a portion submitted by our dues. We generally give to 4-5 families and purchase gifts from their Wish List totaling \$50-60 per family member. Fortunately in the 2019 Holiday Season we were able to help several families and give about \$75-80 per family member.

Unfortunately, given the cancellation of our fundraising events and our annual Christmas program we will not be able to raise the money as we have traditionally done and are reaching out to you, our Ladies of the Yacht Club for your kind donations for our families-in-need. We currently have \$371 in our account to be allocated to the families-in-need for the Holiday giving from a couple fundraising events and contributions.

We kindly ask for any monetary or gift donations you may wish to contribute this holiday season. We know these times may be difficult but any donation would be greatly appreciated.
