Soon a Burgee will be added to our collection in the Swan room.

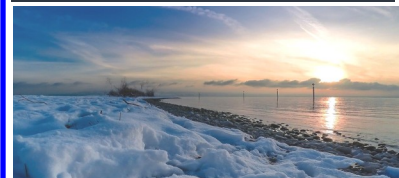
