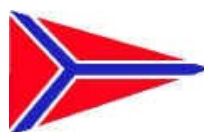
## Letter from Commodore Randy Drumm

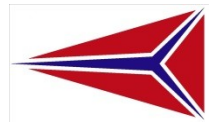
