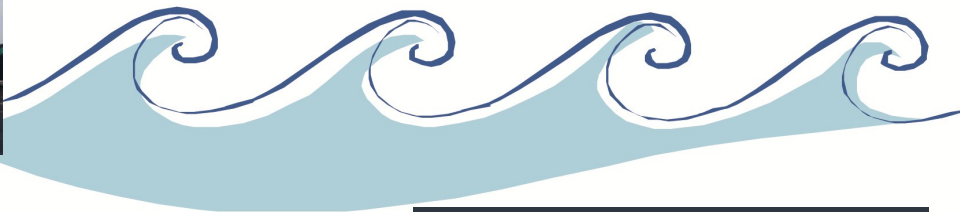

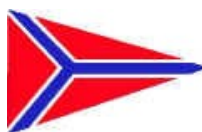

As always, the Ladies of the Yacht Club will not meet in June, July or August, with meetings to resume again on September 9!



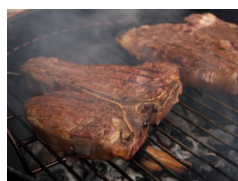

(don't sign up if you are having steak)



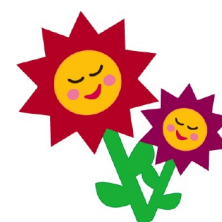

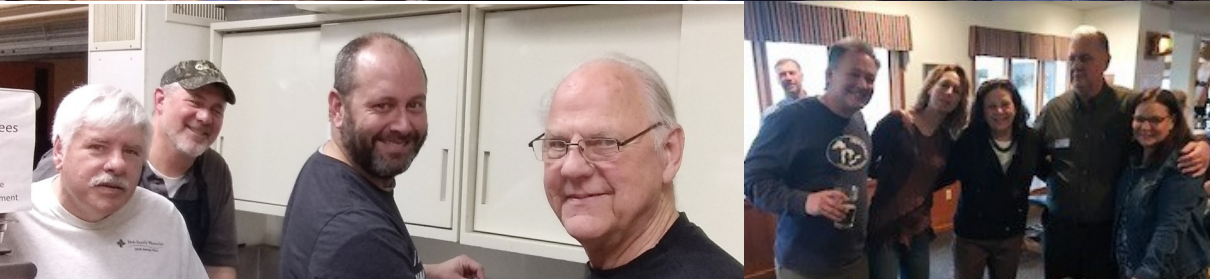
