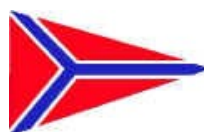
Letter from Commodore Dick Metzger

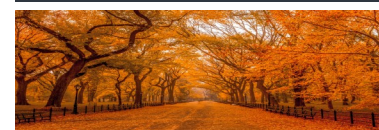
