Information

It was suggested that the process for submitting a new member should be in the Waves.

Process for submitting a new member to the Yacht Club:

- 1] The SPONSOR (the member proposing a new member) completes the New Member Proposal Form with the SPONSOR's information on top and the proposed new member's information at the bottom.
- 2) The SPONSOR presents the New Member Proposal Form in person at the next Board Meeting.
- 3) After presenting, the Secretary receives the New Member Proposal Form.
- 4) The names and addresses of the new members are posted on the bulletin board after the meeting until the next month's Board meeting.
- 5) At the next month's Board meeting, the Commodore asks if there is any discussion on the newly proposed members from last month's meeting.
- 6) After the Board's approval, the Secretary will then send a letter and an "Application for Membership" form to the SPONSOR. It is the SPONSOR's responsibility to make sure the new member completes the application form by the deadline (which is 60 days from the date of the letter).
- 7) After completion of the Application for Membership, the newly proposed member must sign the form, along with the SPONSOR's signature and one other yacht club member.
- 8) Once the completed/signed forms are received at the club, they are stamped with the date they are received, and the newly proposed member's name is added to the "Current MYC Waiting List", which is also posted on the bulletin board.

The forms can be obtained at the Yacht Club or on the website.
