Letter from Commodore Randy Drumm

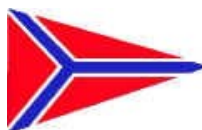

for families in need” project. Your input will be greatly appreciated.

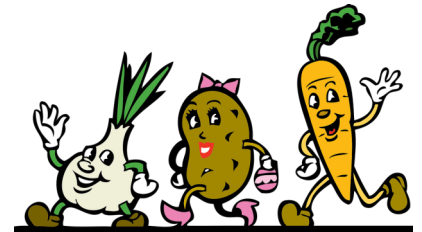

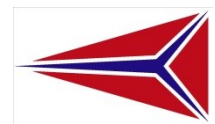
