

Events and Information





A fun race will take place at **1PM**, **Saturday**, **July 9**, **2022**. This challenge is intended to encourage adventure, sailing skills, and friendly competition in the tradition of sailing off of Manitowoc. While also a race, the primary focus of this challenge is accomplishing the goal of completing the course smoothly, while enjoying the camaraderie of sailors.

We will have two Jib and Main divisions, to break the fleet into groups of similar sized boats. Information on the course and other details will be supplied at the skippers meeting at 11am Sat. July 9th outside of the Manitowoc Marina boaters' lounge.

Course: ~ 8 miles, around marks set off of the Manitowoc shoreline. The course will consist of two laps around a rough triangle with marks set to provide one upwind leg if practical, and a couple of reaching legs. By making the course twice around, the course can easily be shortened if the Race Committee decides there is not enough wind to sail twice around. This will also keep the course relatively close to shore, and by going twice around, the fleet should stay closer together.

The safety of each yacht and her crew is the sole and inescapable responsibility of the owner and skipper, who must ensure that the yacht is fully found, thoroughly seaworthy, and the crew fit for the challenge.

Awards: There will be a traveling Trophy awarded to the Overall corrected time winner of the Challenge. Flags will be awarded to the top three finishers on corrected time in each section.

After Challenge party: There will be a Chili themed dinner provided at the Manitowoc Yacht Club the evening of the Challenge starting at 5PM. There will be a cash bar. All participants and crew are invited to dine for no additional cost. Other interested non-participant parties are welcome to dine for a \$10 fee, collectable at the door.

A final scratch sheet and section break will be provided at the skippers meeting. Ratings will follow LMPHRF Jib and Main ratings where possible. Decisions on ratings are made by the racing chair and not subject to appeal.

Other Notes: The goal is a fun race, and although the racing rules will be followed, we do not encourage protests and there will be no formal protest hearing procedures. If there is an egregious foul committed or clear violation of the rules, the racing chair can disqualify the offending boat. This decision would be final and not subject to appeal.

Recommended Equipment and Use: For equipping the yacht, we recommend skippers should use as a guide the US Sailing "Recommendations for Offshore Sailing" for category-three races. We will not be inspecting boats and full compliance with the US Sailing recommendations is at the discretion of the skipper. The following requirements must be observed however:

- 1. Each yacht must carry liability insurance.
- 2. Each yacht must meet all Coast Guard safety requirements.
- 3. Each yacht must carry a VHF marine radio telephone with at least channels 6, 16, 22, 69 and WX. Channel 69 will be used for Race Committee communication.

4. Life jackets are recommended to be worn at all times. It is required that a PFD be worn at all times during severe weather conditions.

Entry Procedure: please bring your completed entry form, and the \$20 entry fee to the skippers' meeting.

IMPORTANT NOTE: In order to have a well-organized event, please notify Ned Jerabek, Sailing Committee Chair Friday July 8th if you are planning to enter the Chili Cup.
