
## Letter from Commodore Dick Nitsch

## Club Policies Updated May 2022

#### IT'S YOUR CLUB - LEAVE IT BETTER THAN YOU FOUND IT

- 1. Club Hours: Members: 6 a.m. to 2 a.m.
- 2. Any member in the club after 2 a.m. will be responsible for any fines or fees related to an after-hour security response.
- 3. NO CARRY-INS are allowed anywhere on the Yacht Club grounds with an exception to wine brought into the club and subject to the established corking fee. All beverages purchased and consumed outside of the Yacht Club building must be in a plastic or metallic container.
- 4. No hats are allowed while eating in the dining room unless there is a reasonable medical exemption.
- 5. Members must CLEAN UP after themselves and their guests. Members are expected to Clean-up their glasses and napkins and dispose of any cans. This includes tables in the White Swan Room, areas around the bar, and the outside patio.
- 6. Under no circumstances are non-members or minors permitted behind the bar.
- 7. No children should be seated at the bar during periods of heavy demand (full or close to full bar).
- 8. No children are allowed in the galley without parental supervision.
- 9. The last person leaving the club is responsible for checking the doors to ensure they are closed and locked.
- 10. Any form of employee harassment is unacceptable. Infractions of any kind will be referred to the Yacht Club Board for possible disciplinary action. The board will consider the severity of the harassment and any past infractions to determine what action needs to be taken, including the possibility of suspension or expulsion from the club. Complaints can be submitted to any Officer of the Board of Directors or any member of the Board.
- 11. All visiting LMYA member's first drink is on the house as long as the guest log is signed.
- 12. The bar will always be closed during Membership Meetings.
- 13. Friday Night Dining Payment Policy Only members may purchase food. If members bring guests to the Club, the members must purchase the food for their guests. The guests may choose to reimburse members for these expenses, but that transaction must be between them. The club can accept payments only from its members. Beverages may be purchased by members or guests. The Manitowoc Yacht Club is registered with the IRS as a 501(c)7 organization (a not-for-profit social club). As such, we are eligible for certain exemptions and obligated to follow IRS rules and guidelines.
- 14. The Yacht Club does not accept the practice of establishing bar or food tabs.
- 15. No animals are allowed in the Club, with the exception of registered service dogs.
- 16. Sign in for Friday Night dining at the podium. The waitress will find you per the order of sign-in to take your order. If you are not ready to order, you will be moved to the bottom of the list.
- 17. Once you are notified to go to your table, please do so promptly. If you do not, the waitress may have to put your food out even if you are not there. They cannot hold it in the kitchen for you to be ready.
- 18. Members have Club rights/access at all times, including during <u>all</u> private parties, but must respect the party and guests.
- 19. Private parties are submitted to the Private Party Chairperson and may be subject to the approval of the House Committee and the Yacht Club Board of Directors.
- 20. All scheduled Yacht Club activities have priority over private party considerations.
