Letter from Commodore Mike Haucke

I am writing this on 2/25, and it looks like we will not have Hamburger and Chili night in March as no one stepped up to be the host. Our April Hamburger and Chili night will again be hosted by Apprentices, who have tagged it "Garbage" Hamburger and Chili night and have asked that the profits help fund the new \$4,200 commercial kitchen garbage disposal that we need. I'm positive their tag has nothing to do with the delicious hamburgers, cheeseburgers, and chili they will serve. There's a rumor that the Chili King, who prepares chili for The Fat Seagull, will make the chili for that April event. You better come down and check it out. We need hosts for the remainder of the 2023 Hamburger and Chili nights. Please consider hosting an upcoming Steak Night or Hamburger and Chili Night.

I have commissioned a By-Law review committee comprising board members and members at large. Besides several grammatical changes, I have asked for specific areas of focus. The By-Law review committee will work for a few months and potentially develop recommendations for





the Board of Directors to consider. Once the Board completes its review, it will present any changes to the membership for approval. The membership approval of any changes to the By-Laws has to take place at our October annual meeting, and I'm hoping for all that to happen in 2023.

Here are the items I have asked the By-Law review to consider:

- Should there be a provision for the Board of Directors to approve a suspension of any By-Law provision if the situation warrants?
- Should we add a provision to make yacht owners with a permanent slip in Manitowoc County eligible for MYC membership even if

- 3) Should we limit the number of new membership proposals each member can submit?
- 4) Should we clarify if a member can participate (as opposed to attending as an observer) in a board meeting and what has to happen to allow participation?
- 5) Should we add the Grievance/Complaint Referral and Review Process to the By-Laws?
- 6) Should we state the number of memberships allowed at MYC in the By-Laws?
- 7) Should we state in the By-Laws that Life Memberships are not counted in the active memberships count?

If you have thoughts on these ideas, please come to the membership meetings and provide feedback. The next membership meeting is on Tuesday, March 28th, at 7 pm. To review the current By-Laws, download a copy of the Membership Handbook attached to the Friday Dining emails.


